ISSUES OF TODAY: Impacts of the Mountain Pine Beetle Outbreak

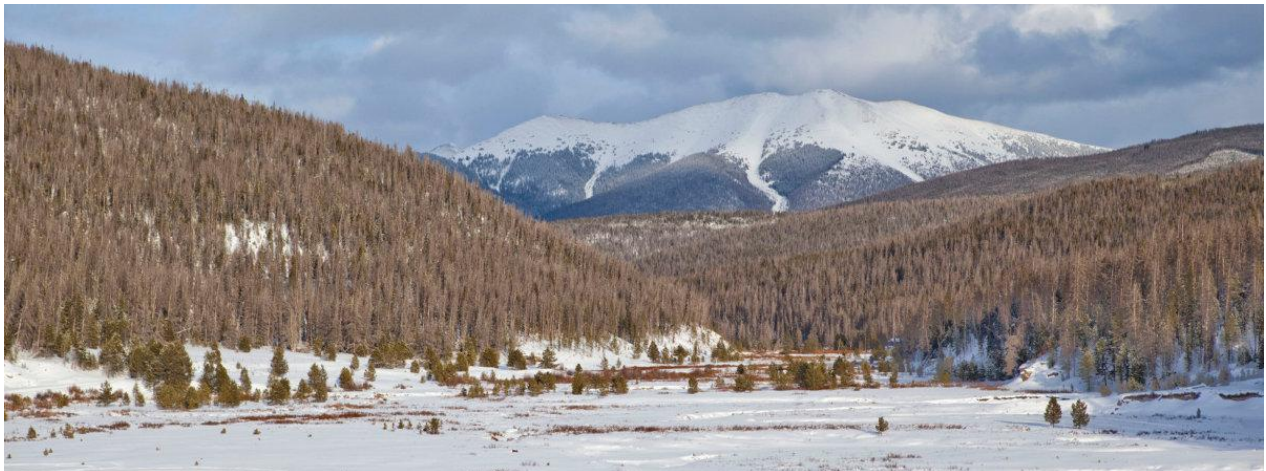
